#### **Notice of Race**

**ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:** Peninsula Youth Sailing Foundation (PYSF) is the organizing authority, in conjunction with PCISA and the NorCal League.

**LOCATION & RACING AREA:** PYSF, 1200 Chesapeake Dr., Redwood City, CA 94305. Racing will be located in the turning basin in the vicinity of PYSF.

**RULES:** The RRS of 2009-2012 apply, as modified by the ISSA and PCISA Procedural Rules, the provisions for 2012-2013 Nor-Cal league regattas, and the Sailing Instructions.

#### **ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & ENTRY FEE, REGISTRATION:**

- The regatta is open to all High School Teams registered for the 2012-2013 PCISA season. Each team consists of 2 sailors who attend the same school (see NorCal Substitution Provisions).
- Deadline to Register is Wednesday, November 14<sup>th</sup>. Please complete entry form and submit via fax to 650-649-2320 or email to Molly at [obryan.molly@gmail.com](mailto:obryan.molly@gmail.com)
- Entry fee is \$20.00 per competitor, per day. Please make checks payable to "PYSF." Registration Checks will be collected the morning of racing at Sequoia Yacht Club.
- Each team must provide one class legal CFJ, including sails with distinct NorCal-assigned sail numbers. There will be no boat rotations.
- Each team will race in either Gold or Silver Fleet. These divisions will be predetermined by the teams' own coach
- Spectators and visiting coaches can view the racing from the docks/grass adjacent to Sequoia Yacht Club. Swapping of crews can be done from team's coach boats or the public launch ramp. The public docks adjacent to grass are occupied.
- Boats will be stored in a public parking lot. Items left inside the boat will be left at the owner's risk.
- Awards will be given to the top 3 teams in both the Gold and Silver Fleets for each regatta.

**9-10am** Registration at Sequoia Yacht Club, light breakfast and coffee

**9-10am** Rig and Launch. (As this is a public boat ramp we must use only one side of the dock. When launching keep an eye out for others launching powerboats, and keep at least half of the ramp and the road accessible to the public. The floating dock is off limits).

**10:30** Competitor's Meeting at top of Boat Ramp

**11:30** First Warning

**4:30pm** Last Warning Signal

**5:30** Snacks and Awards at Sequoia Yacht Club
